




To vote for a candidate, fill in the box to the left of the name of the person for whom you desire to vote. To vote for a person not on the ballot, write the name of the candidate in the space provided and fill in the box to the left of the write-in space.</p> <p>More than one vote for an office will be an overvote and no votes for that office will be counted.</p> <p>If you sign or otherwise identify yourself on the ballot, the ballot will not be counted.</p> <p>Voters with disabilities may choose to use the accessible voting machine in the Elections Office located at 55 Second Street, Suite A, Friday Harbor, 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. weekdays and until 8:00 p.m. on election day.</p> <p>To correct your vote on a race, draw a line through the candidate's entire name. You then have the option of making another choice if you wish.
